



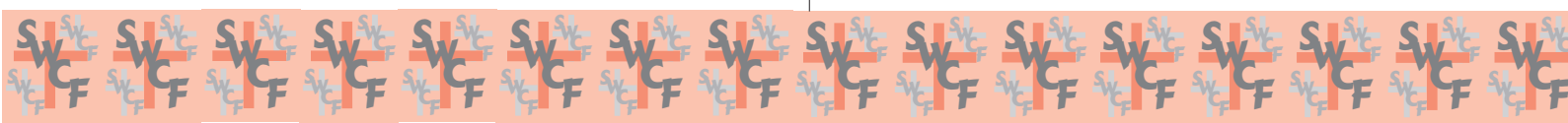

SWCF is a national organisation for Christians who work in a wide variety of social work, social care, social action and student settings. Formed in 1964, SWCF provides professional and spiritual support to its members, through national and local events.

It is interdenominational, and is affiliated to organisations with similar aims. SWCF seeks to develop Biblical thinking, challenge secular assumptions, and promote Christian perspectives in policy-making and practice.

There are reduced subscription rates for students, the low paid and the unwaged. There is also a Bursary Fund to enable participation in the Fellowship activities.

Membership is for one calendar year from the date of joining.

Members are encouraged to subscribe through Gift Aid, as SWCF is able to reclaim the tax.
